

July Sailboat

Fabric:

sky: light blue
water: dark blue
boat: colorful
sails: white or colorful

Cutting:

sky: (2) $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles
(2) $4\frac{1}{2}''$ squares
sails: (2) $4\frac{1}{2}''$ squares
boat: (1) $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle
water (1) $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle
(2) $3\frac{1}{2}''$ squares

Piecing:

With right sides together use the sail and sky $4\frac{1}{2}''$ squares to make 4 half square triangles.

Trim to $3\frac{1}{2}''$ squares.

Sew together into a four patch as shown.

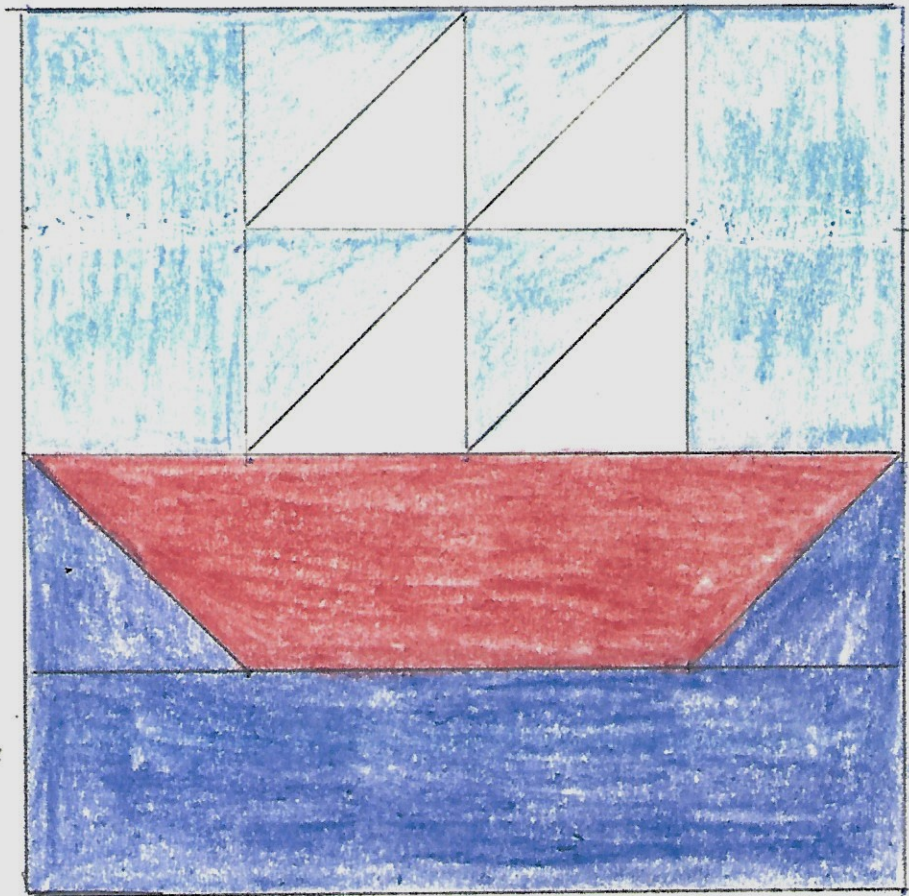
Add a $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ sky rectangle to each side.

Press seams toward sky.

Draw a diagonal line on the back of each water

$3\frac{1}{2}''$ square. Place right sides together on the boat rectangle as shown. Sew on line. Trim seam to $\frac{1}{4}''$.

Sew the water rectangle to the bottom of the boat. Press toward the water rectangle.



Sew the two pieces together, and press seam open. Block should measure $12\frac{1}{2}''$ square
