## Puyallup Valley Quilters Board Meeting for August 10, 2020

**Attendees:** Patti Asamura, Kim Smith, Diane Thompson, Sarah DeLaRosa, Susan Butenko, Colleen Wise, Susan Treloar, Kathy Clark, Kat Stahl, Janet Casement

Vice President Patti Asamura called meeting to order at 7:14pm.

\*A motion to accept the July 6, 2020 board meeting minutes was made by Kat Stahl, seconded by Colleen Wise and passed.  
\*A motion was made by Kim Smith that the 2020-2021 Dues be reduced by half, to \$25. Diane Thompson 2nd, motion passed. (See Membership)

Patti suggested an idea to have a “member spotlight” at our meetings. Ask for a volunteer to tell about themselves or share their sewing room. Would ask for volunteer the month before so they can prepare. Patti also suggested having a “quilting” get together in a parking lot 1-2 times a month. Members could bring chairs and hand work or just come to visit with each other while social distancing outside.

**Programs:** Colleen Wise suggested at the Zoom meetings to have one member per month volunteer to have a show and share of their projects and or the sewing studios.

Zoom meetings will be the way we continue to meet. Coffee hour and Happy Hours will help members become acquainted with Zoom. Contact Colleen Wise if you are having trouble. Colleen asked how far out she should schedule speakers via Zoom. Board told her at least until the end of the year. Colleen will schedule a “coffee hour” for Saturday Aug 15th 11am.

**Membership:** Patti Asamura suggested that the Puyallup Valley Quilters membership for the 2020-2021 be reduced to \$25.00. ### Seabeck Retreat-Fall 2020 October 14-18

With a heavy heart we have made the difficult decision to cancel the October 14-18 Seabeck Retreat. With so many of those regularly expressing concern during this COVID - 19/pandemic, we cannot meet the agreed number of attendees for the retreat. Most if not all of our retreat attendees fall into that 60 & over age group and are considered at risk. And as of this time, Seabeck does not know when the state will allow them to invite groups in to enjoy time there. We thought it best to make a decision sooner rather than later. This is the 2nd retreat I have missed at Seabeck in more than 30 years. And I am at the verge of tears just thinking about missing it and that special time with friends and fellow quilters.

The good news is that Seabeck has reserved our dates for 2021! The dates are October 13-17 for full time attendees, and October 14-17 for part time attendees, and our deposit will be transferred to that time. So if you have made a deposit for this fall's retreat, it will be transferred to the fall 2021 retreat at Seabeck. If you have made a deposit and requested a refund which was sent to you, you will need to resubmit a \$50.00 deposit in order for us to reserve a spot for you. I would like to have deposits by October 31, however, I will take them thru the year, until spaces are filled. Those of you who have not paid a deposit will be eligible on a first come first serve basis.
