

Beach Huts

Time to be creative.

Fabrics

Light blue: (sky)

(1) $12\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ strip

(6) $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ squares

yellow or tan: (sand)

(6) $4\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ rectangles

or

(1) $12\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ rectangle

scraps of bright colors, stripes, polka dots, prints

doors: cut (3) $1\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$

roofs: cut (3) $4\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$

or

cut $4\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ squares

sides beside door:

cut 2" x $2\frac{1}{2}$ rectangles

3 matching sets of 2.

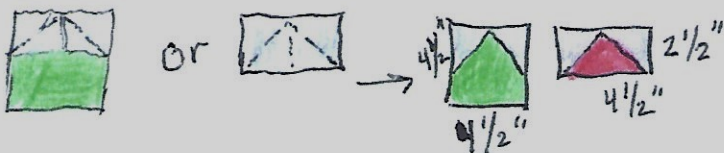
if you cut $4\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ roofs you will need a $4\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ piece to match the $2" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$ pieces beside the door.

Piecing:

Sand: use a $12\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ rectangle or sew together the six $4\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ rectangles.

Beach huts:

Sew a $2" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangle to each side of a $1\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangle. Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}"$ square of light blue to each side of the $4\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$ roof OR to the top of a $4\frac{1}{2}"$ square.



Assemble huts as shown:
should be $4\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$.



sew huts together. Sew $2\frac{1}{2} \times 12\frac{1}{2}$ blue rectangle to top. Sew Sand section to the bottom. Square should be $12\frac{1}{2} \times 12\frac{1}{2}$
