

June Strawberry

cutting:

dark green:

cut one stem using template

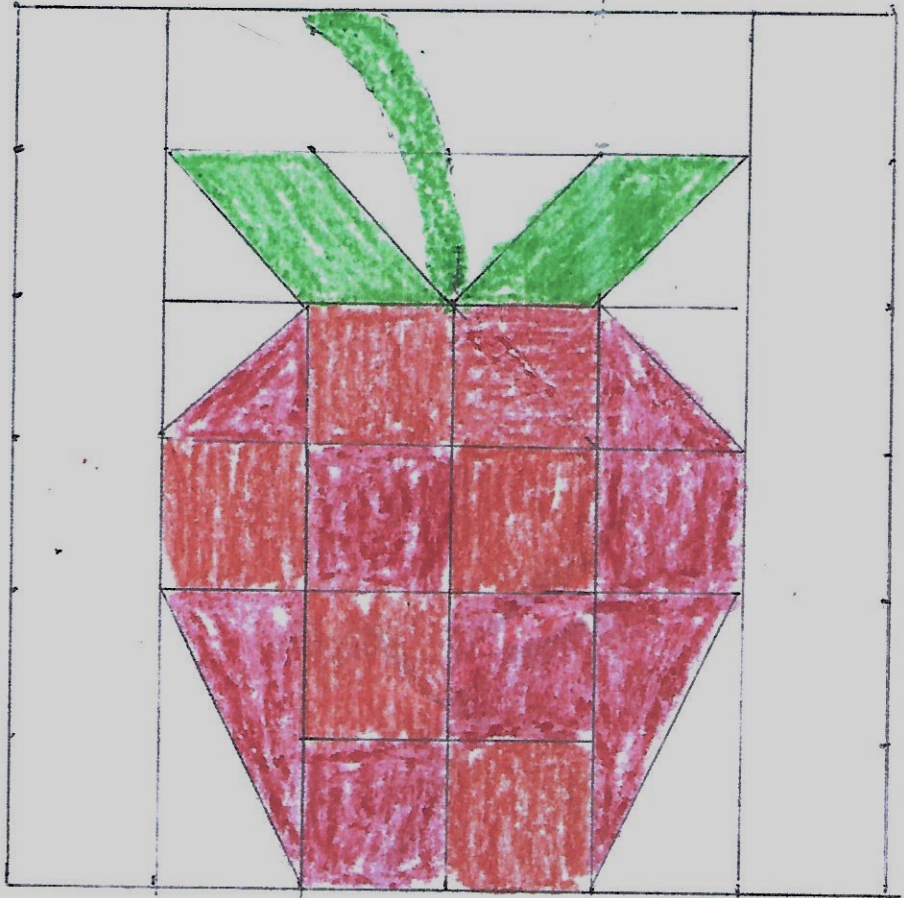
cut (2) $4\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

dark and medium reds

cut 10 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

cut 1 $3\frac{1}{4}$ " square

cut 2 $3\frac{1}{4} \times 5$ " rectangles



background

cut (2) $12\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

cut (1) $8\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

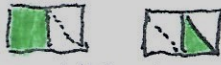
cut (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

cut (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " square

cut (2) $3\frac{1}{4} \times 5$ " rectangles

Piecing:

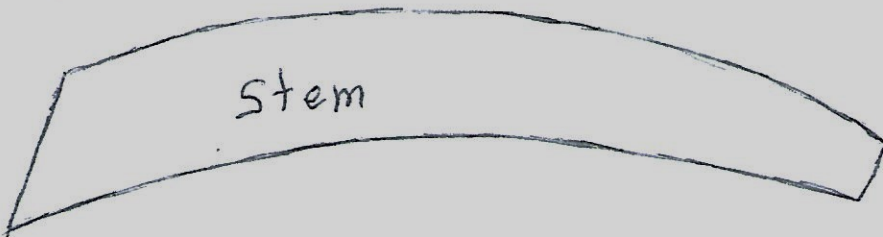
For the leaves put the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares to each end of the green rectangles as shown.



Sew the two rectangles together. Sew the $8\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangle to the top. Applique the stem between the leaves using your favorite method.

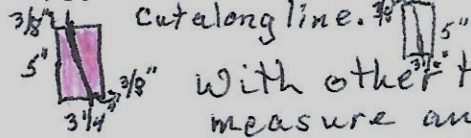
Use the red and background $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares to make 2 half square triangles. Trim to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Sew the top two rows of the strawberry as shown.

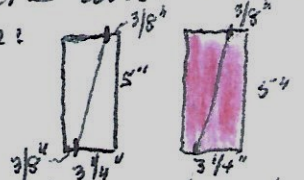


Sides of Strawberry:

Take one $3\frac{1}{4} \times 5$ " background rectangle and one red $3\frac{1}{4} \times 5$ " rectangle. Measure $3\frac{1}{8}$ " in from side as shown. Cut along line.



With other two rectangles, measure and cut as shown:



Combine one background and one red as shown. Trim to $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ ".



make a 4-patch with red $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Sew the rectangles to each side. Sew to the top two rows.

Sew strawberry to leaf unit. Sew $12\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangles to each side.
