

October Pumpkin Harvest

Fabric: assorted oranges
medium green
light background

Cutting:

cut (5) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles
from assorted oranges

cut (1) $2\frac{1}{2}''$ square of green

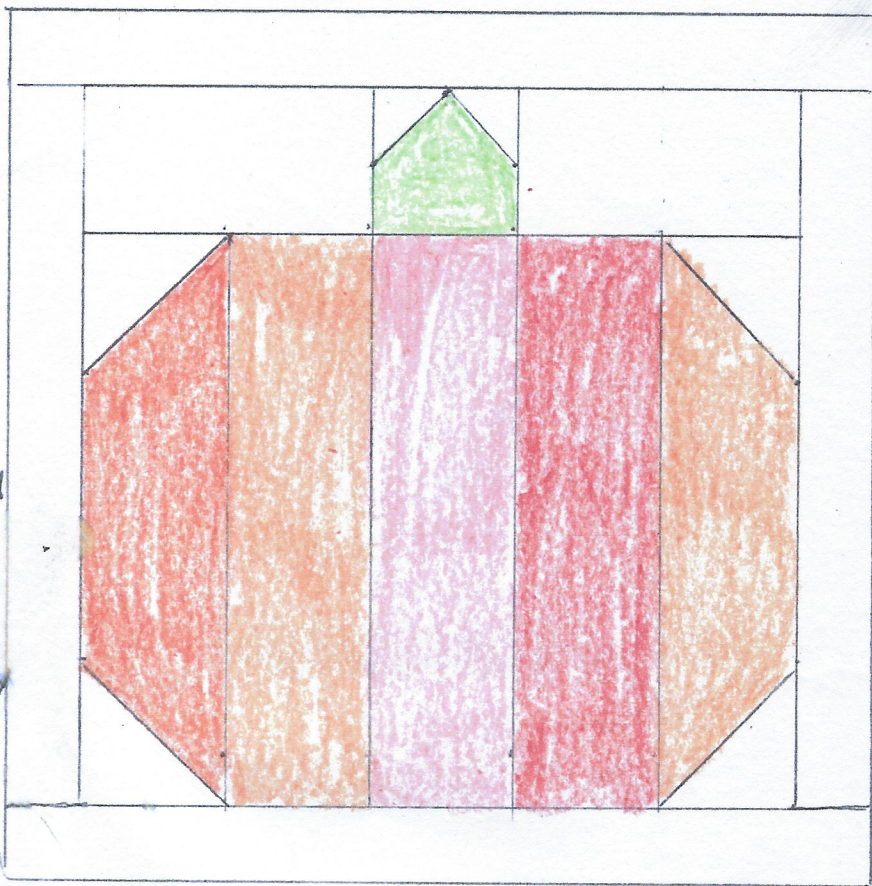
cut (4) $2\frac{1}{2}''$ squares of background

cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}''$ squares of background

cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles
of background

cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles background

cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles background



Piecing: Using the stitch-

and-flip method sew
 $1\frac{1}{2}''$ background squares to the
top of the green $2\frac{1}{2}''$ square

make 1  

Use two $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles
and the $2\frac{1}{2}''$ background squares
to make side units using the
stitch-and-flip method



make 2

Sew the 5 assorted orange
strips together as shown. Press
seams toward middle.

Sew the $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ background
rectangles to the green unit
press away from the green
unit.

Sew to the top of the pumpkin.

Sew the $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles to the
sides. Sew the $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles to
the top and bottom. Press seams
to $1\frac{1}{2}''$ units. Block should measure
 $12\frac{1}{2}''$ square.
