

Holiday Wreath

Colors: lt. green, dk green
white or off-white, red

Cutting: I am giving the directions for dark green in the center as shown. You can switch them if you prefer. It looks good either way.

Red: 5 pieces $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square
White: 4 pieces $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square
4 pieces $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square

light green:

(4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square D
(2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " E
(2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " A
(2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " I
(2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " J

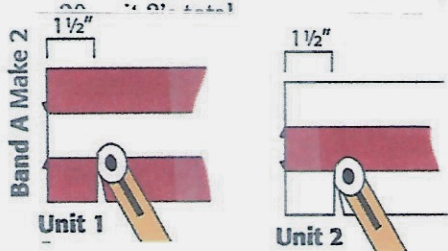
dark green:

(4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square B
(2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " H
(2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " C

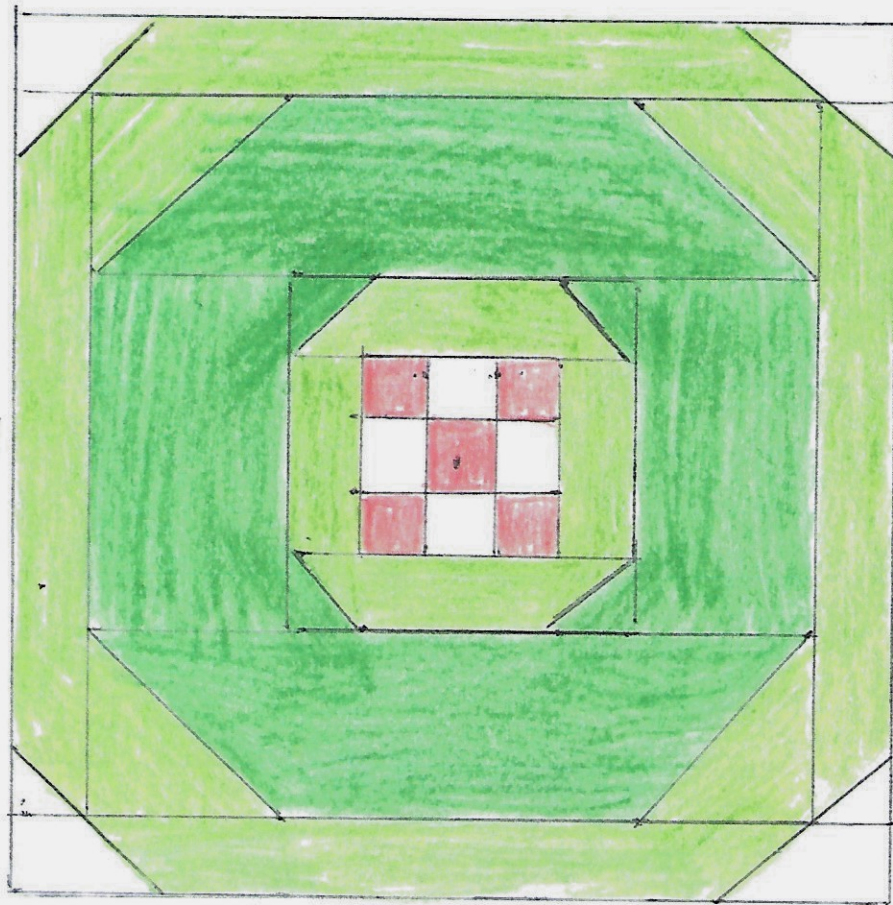
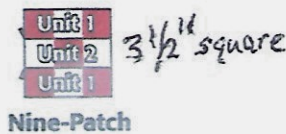
Piecing: Instead of cutting $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares of red and white, you can cut 3 $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces of each and follow the directions below.

Sew 2 red strips and 1 cream strip together as shown to make band A. Make 2 bands. Cut the bands at $1\frac{1}{2}$ " increments to make 20 unit 1's

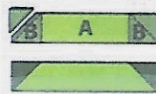
In the same manner, join 2 cream strips and 1 red strip together as shown to make band B. Cut the bands at $1\frac{1}{2}$ " increments to make 20 unit 2's total.



Sew 2 unit 1's and 1 unit 2 together as shown to make a Nine-Patch. Make 20 Nine-Patches total.

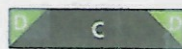


Refer to "Stitch-and-Flip" in Basic Lessons. Use light green A and 2 dark green B's to make unit 3 as shown. Make 20 unit 3's total.



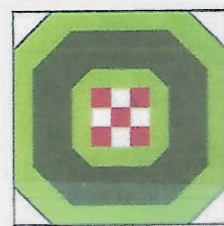
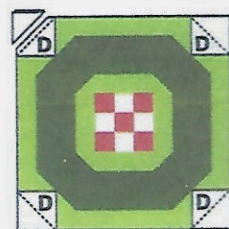
Unit 3

In the same way, make units 5 in the colors and quantities shown.



Unit 5

Sew Nine-Patch, 2 unit 3's and matching G's, 2 unit 5's, and matching H's, matching I's and matching J's together as shown. Using stitch-and-flip method, add 4 cream D's to corners to make a block Y. Make 10 block Y's total.
