

Coffee Cup

Cutting:

for cup: cut one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square
cut handle from template

background:

cut 2 $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
cut 1 $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle
cut 4 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

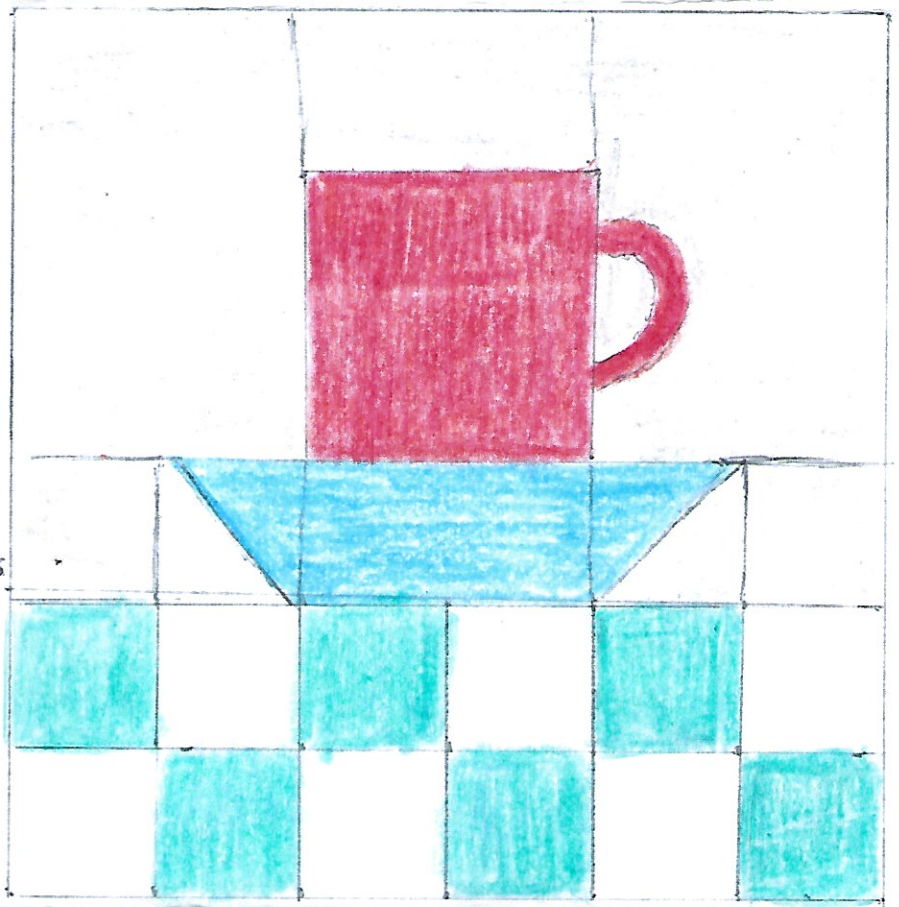
tablecloth:

cut a total of 12 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
from 2 fabrics

saucer:

cut one $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

This is a make-it fun
pattern so use fun fabrics.




To make saucer; draw a diagonal
line on the background squares.



pin to
saucer
fabric
as shown

sew along lines. Trim excess
fabric $\frac{1}{4}$ " from seam and press
outward. Sew the other two
 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to each end.



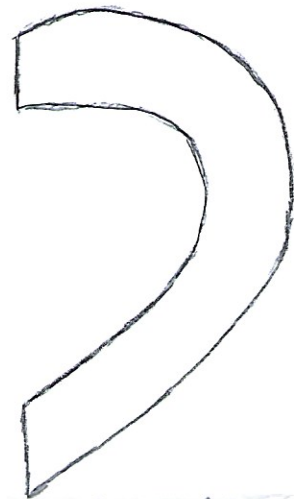
Sew the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background to
the cup fabric. Applique the
cup handle to one of the
large background rectangles.
Sew one rectangle to each
side of the  cup fabric.

Alternate each tablecloth square
to make a checkerboard tablecloth.
Press seams to one color. Press
center seam open.

Sew cup piece to saucer piece.
Press seam open.

Sew cup and saucer unit to checker-
board unit. Press seam open.

Square should measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "
