

Arkansas Snowflake

Fabric:

medium or dark blue
or dark gray for background
white on white and lt. gray or
light blue for snowflake.

Cutting:

background: (4) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
one piece $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20 " rectangle folded
in half right sides out to make
a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 " rectangle. Cut 4
half triangles. With fold will make 1st part.
Snowflake: cut (1) $3\frac{3}{4}$ " square of
each cut in half diagonally.

cut (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " isosceles triangles
of each color.

Use Tri Rec tools to cut triangles or
use templates.

Piecing:

Use triangles to make center
square. Press seams to colored
triangle. Press center seam open.
Trim to $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Sew half triangles to each side
of isosceles triangles. Press seams
toward background.

Sew rows together as shown.
Press rows 1 + 3 seams out.
Press row 2 seams toward
center.
