

October Cat

Fabrics: shades of black and dark gray
Use the darkest for ears and tail

background: Use a paler fabric; I used orange. Yellow or blue would work well.

Cutting:

For tail and ears:

(2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

(2) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares

(1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

For muzzle: lightest black or gray.

(2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square

(1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

Background:

(2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square

(1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " square

(1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

(1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

Body:

(2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square

(1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " square

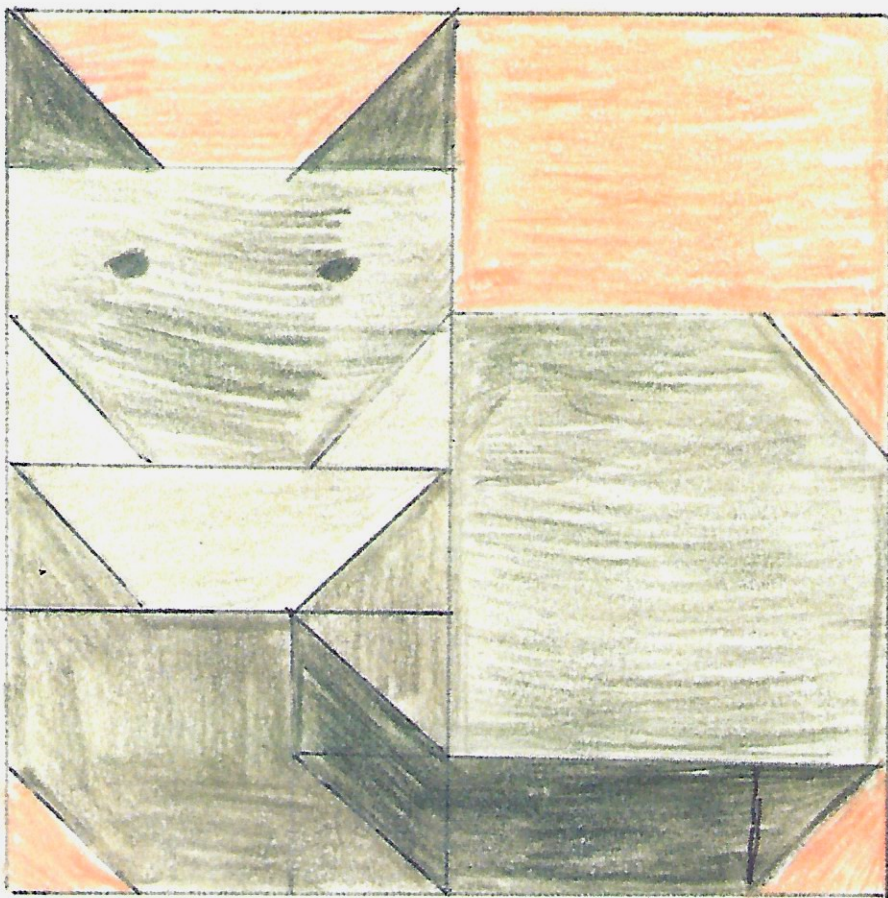
(1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square

(1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square

(1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

Sewing:

Use $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares to make half-square triangles. Press toward darkest material and FRIM to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Put one half square with background at the end of the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " tail as shown. Sew the half square triangle squares




together as shown  tail section

Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background square to the top right hand corner of the $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background square to the bottom left corner of the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Sew the tail section to the right side.

Sew $2\frac{1}{2}$ " black squares to the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle as shown  to make ears.

Sew $2\frac{1}{2}$ " light squares to $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle on bottom corners as shown.

Sew $2\frac{1}{2}$ " body squares to $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " light rectangle like ear unit.

Sew ear unit to head. Press seam to head. Sew muzzle unit to head. Press seam open. Add chest and tail unit. Press seam open.

Sew other units together as shown. Press seams up toward top.

Sew two sides together. Press to the right. Should measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
